DOMINICAN SOUL BY THE SEA

At **Secrets Tides Punta Cana**, untamed nature meets contemporary calm.

Secrets Tides Punta Cana commands Uvero Alto's wild Dominican coastline, bringing modern, adults-only luxury to nearly 800 feet of palm-lined sand. The lobby frames tropical foliage and ocean views that appear both hidden and expansive. The 668 suites feel more like a residential enclave than a hotel, each defined by unique character, curated art, and furnished patios or swim-out pools. Palm wood, stone, glass, and water draw the eye outward to the coast beyond.

At the spa, sunlight floods the hydrotherapy circuit while treatment rooms open along its edge. In oceanfront cabanas, couples share a quiet connection as warm oils and the sound of waves erase the last trace of the world outside. Culinary highlights are bold and curated like Mediterranean-Asian fusion at Meraki, Amazon-inspired dishes at Tierra, and seafood drawn fresh from the Atlantic. Each restaurant reflects a facet of the Dominican spirit—vibrant, generous, and open-hearted.

MARITIME MARVEL

Hotel Indigo Grand Cayman carries the island's seafaring past onto Seven Mile Beach.

Hotel Indigo Grand Cayman channels the spirit of world-famous Seven Mile Beach through shifting light, sun-bleached wood, vermilion stone, and ocean blues that ripple through the interiors like a current. Rooms open to verandas that pull in salt air and sea views, the hotel's pink seashell façade catching the same glow that shimmers on open water.

Dining leans into Cayman's coastal bounty—lionfish ceviche kissed with lime, conch fritters laced with Scotch bonnet, and grilled snapper finished with rum-glazed plantains. At the rooftop bar Pom Pom, locals and travelers gather as the sun dips toward the Caribbean, cocktails in hand and trade winds curling through the air. Art and design reflect a maritime heritage shaped by exploration and craftsmanship, while infinity pools share views once charted by navigators. The location places guests within easy reach of Grand Cayman's reef-protected North Sound, world-class snorkeling, and the cosmopolitan flavor of George Town's duty-free shops.

PLAYA GRANDE, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Amanera, meaning “peaceful water,” rests above the cliffs of Playa Grande on the Dominican Republic’s north coast, overlooking an untouched mile-long beach. The resort’s 370 acres of jungle and sea hold just 24 casitas and one casa, each shaped by warm woods, vaulted ceilings, and discreet balconies.

THE VIBE: Mornings echo to birdcalls, evenings fall into silence broken only by surf. The Atlantic surrounds you in sound, wind, and light.

FOOD & DRINK: At Casa Grande, chefs grill spiny lobster and slice mango bright with lime, while the Beach Club serves fresh ceviche and chilled rosé beside the surf.

DON'T MISS: A cliff-top hike across the resort’s private mountain, followed by a rum masterclass with Amanera’s rummellers, who pair aged Dominican rums with organic chocolate.

MONTEGO BAY, JAMAICA

Half Moon opened in 1954 and remains one of the Caribbean’s few family-owned resorts. Conceived by 17 families as a discreet seaside retreat, it still carries that spirit of quiet elegance across 400 acres and two miles of shoreline. Three distinct settings define the property: Founders Cove, rich in classic Caribbean charm; Eclipse, with its modern beachfront sophistication; and Villas at Half Moon, expansive estates complete with individual pools and butler service.

THE VIBE: Whitewashed cottages and breezy verandas evoke Jamaica’s colonial past, but it’s the warmth of longtime staff and the way generations return to greet them that gives the resort its soul.

FOOD & DRINK: Sugar Mill redefines Jamaican cuisine with rum-glazed pork, curry-spiced ahi tuna, and herbs gathered just steps from the kitchen.

DON'T MISS: The Swim with Horses experience, when a morning ride along the beach gives way to surf and salt spray as horse and rider splash into the sea together.

ST. BARTH, ST. BARTHÉLEMY

French savoir-faire meets Caribbean ease at Cheval Blanc St-Barth, holding the region’s only Palace distinction. Sitting quietly along Flamands Beach, the Maison (Cheval Blanc’s signature term for its hotels) rests on one of the island’s widest arcs of seaside tucked behind lush, overflowing gardens. FOOD & DRINK: A selection of Casparian caviar crowns the menu at La Case, presented with the art of French service.

DON'T MISS: A catamaran excursion arranged by the Maison, drifting across turquoise bays before anchoring for a massage at sea and a gourmet picnic on Gouverneur Beach.
